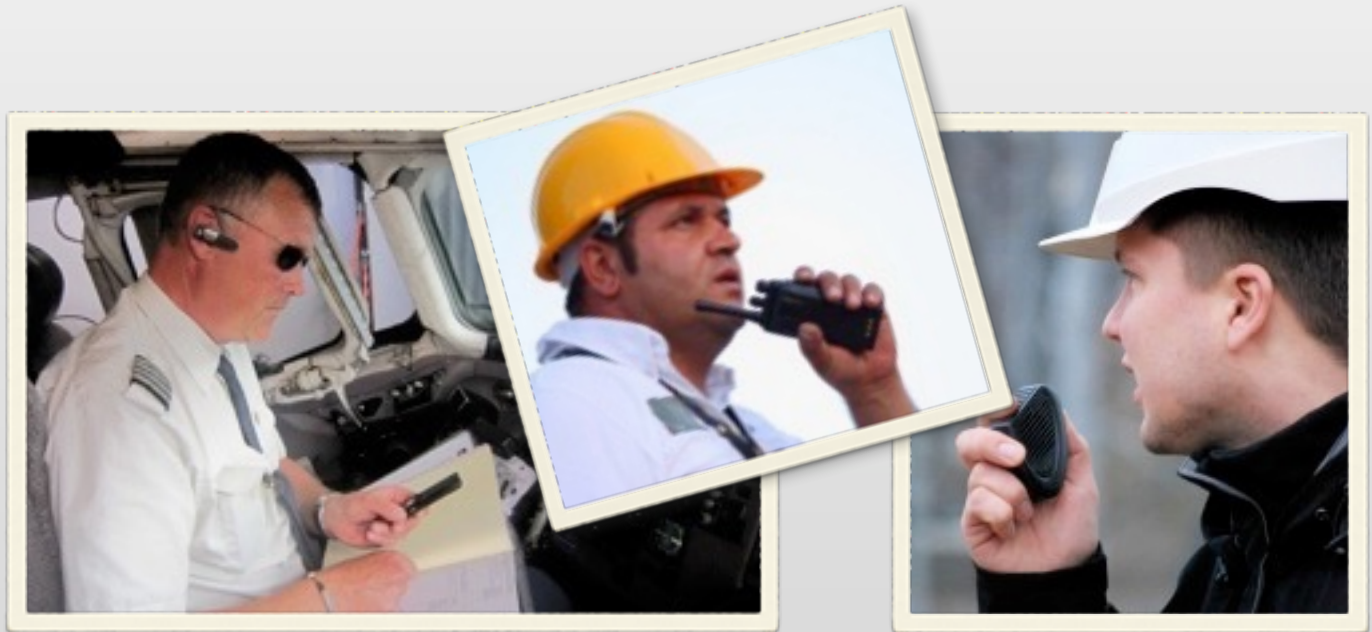

Push-to-Talk (PTT)

GroupTalk provides a PTT service that enables users with mobile phones, PCs and two-way radios to be in constant contact.

Push To Talk is quicker than a phone call (because there is no number to dial), a user simply pushes a button on the phone and talks. Office based users use a PC client and can instantaneously talk with staff in the field. Usage of telecommunication networks and the Internet has the advantage of almost unlimited global coverage.

GroupTalk has the additional benefit of being able to bridge two-way radio users with mobile phone and PC users. Users in a harsh environment can continue to use the two-way radio that they are used to and that meet their requirements.

Mobile app

The GroupTalk mobile app enables users to always be online, since the app can run in the background on your phone.

The presence feature displays which users that is currently online in the PTT group and indicates who is speaking at the moment.

PTT groups are managed centrally and automatically pushed out to the users phones.



PC client

The GroupTalk PC client allows a user to monitor and interact in multiple PTT groups.

The PC client adds value for office-based users that may provide support, dispatcher, expert and security functions and act as a single point of contact to control and support field-personnel

The PC client-user interface is intuitive and easy to use and provides functions to facilitate handling large number of PTT groups and users.

Two-way radio integration

GroupTalk can leverage existing investments in two-way radio systems. Combining two-way radio users with phone and PC users can increase both value and functionality, providing a much better solution than only expanding the two-way radio system.

Two-way radio systems are connected to the GroupTalk service via the Internet, fixed phone lines or via GSM/3G networks.

Multiple dispersed two-way radio systems can also be connected with the GroupTalk service, creating geographically independent radio communication.



Managed service

GroupTalk provides a managed service in the cloud; with a user-friendly web based administration for managing users, user-access rights, PTT-groups and radio-pool setup according to identified communication needs.

Turnkey solution

GroupTalk can be deployed as a turnkey solution on premises, within four walls or in remote locations, such as on a vessel. This solution can be used completely stand alone or in combination with the GroupTalk Managed Service.
